



Notice of Appeal against Chief Psychiatrist's Decision to change category of Forensic Order to Inpatient

*Mental Health Act 2016 Queensland
Sections 313(2), 314(4), 532*

- ◆ A patient who is dissatisfied with the decision of the Chief Psychiatrist to change the category of their Forensic Order to inpatient may appeal the decision to the Mental Health Review Tribunal.
- ◆ The notice of appeal must be given within 28 days after the person making the appeal receives notice of the decision of the Chief Psychiatrist.
- ◆ The Mental Health Review Tribunal may, at any time, extend the time for giving the notice of appeal.
