



Electronic audio recording of hearings

The Mental Health Review Tribunal (Tribunal) is currently undertaking a project in relation to the electronic (audio) recording of hearings.

At a time in the future, the Tribunal would like to electronically record all its hearings. However, before we do that, we are undertaking a trial to see what works and what doesn't.

As part of that trial, at your next hearing, the Tribunal panel may ask you whether you would like the hearing recorded or not. During the trial period, you do not have to agree to the recording. If you don't want your hearing recorded, you can just tell the panel that. Other people at the hearing also have to agree to the recording for it to happen.

If you don't attend the hearing, then it may still be recorded in your absence.

The Tribunal takes privacy and confidentiality very seriously and we have a strict policy in relation to the recording, including how we will make it, how we will store it, how we will use it and how we will manage it .
