

# TRANSCRIPT FOR MHRT VIDEO 3

## AFTER THE HEARING

#	English	Yumplatok
1.	A hearing at the Mental Health Review Tribunal or the MHRT for short, can be stressful and you may not know what will happen next. This video will step through what you can expect.	A miting wea da Mental Health Review Tribunal mait meke yu stresaut ane yu mait no sabe wanem go apen next. Dis video go show yu wanem mait apen.
2.	<b>The Decision</b>	<b>Da Disizan</b>
3.	At the end of the hearing, the MHRT will usually tell you the decision.	Wen da miting e pinis dem MHRT memba go spik yu wanem disizan dempla bin mekem.
4.	This will include whether your involuntary authority or order should continue, whether you should stay in hospital or the community, and whether there should be conditions on what you can and can't do.	Da disizan go spik ip dis involuntary authority o orda baut yu go kip go, o ip yu go stap wea hospital o wea da komuniti, o ip e gad eni rul baut wanem yu ken o kan mekem.
5.	In some cases, the MHRT may need more time to discuss the decision, and you will find out a short time after the hearing.	Samtaimz da MHRT go nid lelbet mo taim po tokbaut wanem dempla go disaid, ane yu go paindaut sam taim apta da miting.
6.	After the hearing is finished, there won't be a chance to speak to the MHRT any further, but you can talk with your support network or treating team, as sometimes you may find the hearing challenging or confronting.	Apta da miting e pinis yu nomo go gad sans po tok po da MHRT, but yu ken tok po dem sapot woka o dem pipol uda trite yu. Samtaimz yu mait go paine da miting go meke yu apset o da disizan bin meke yu pil nugud.
7.	<b>The Decision Notice</b>	<b>Da Leta baut da Disizan</b>
8.	Within 7 days of the MHRT making their decision, you'll receive notice of it in the mail. This is an important document that you should keep.	Wan wik prom da taim da MHRT bin meke dempla disizan, yu go gede leta baut da disizan. Dis wan em prapa impotant leta so mata kipem seip.

9.	You can ask someone in your support network, a member of your treating team, or an Independent Patient Rights Advisor or IPRA, to help you understand all the information in your decision notice.	Po gede sambodi po elpe yu andastan ebri inpomeisan e gad wea da disizan leta, yu ken aske sambodi wea da sapot netwok, memba prom dempla uda trite yu, o Independent Patient Rights Advisor o IPRA.
10.	Requesting a statement of reasons If you would like to know why the MHRT made its decision, you can ask for a statement of reasons by sending us an email or letter. If you don't have access to email, a member of your treating team can email a copy of your letter to the MHRT for you. This request should include your full name, date of birth, and hearing date.	Ip yu wandem yu ken aske da MHRT po dem rizan dempla bin meke dempla disizan. Ip yu sane email o leta u ken aske dempla po rait yu leta baut dem rizan. Ip yu nogad email, memba blo dempla uda trite yu ken email kopi blo da leta yu bin raitem po da MHRT. Dis leta mas gad full neim blo yu, wen yu bin bon ane da deit blo da miting.
11.	The reasons for the decision will be provided to you within 21 days after we receive your request.	Yu go gede ansa baut da rizan po da disizan insaid 21 dei apta MHRT bin gede leta blo yu.
12.	<b>Disagreeing with the MHRT's decision</b>	<b>Ip yu no gri wea da disizan da MHRT bin mekem</b>
13.	If you disagree with the MHRT's decision, you can ask the Mental Health Court to review the matter by lodging an appeal.	Ip yu no gri wea da disizan da MHRT bin mekem yu ken rait leta ane aske da Mental Health Court po paindaut wanem bin apen.
14.	The Mental Health Court is not part of the MHRT and will make its own decision. 15.	Your next hearing Your authority or order will be reviewed on a regular basis. It may be between 6 to 12 months before your next hearing for a Treatment Authority, while hearings for Forensic Orders and Treatment Support Orders are every 6 months.	Neks Miting blo yu Dempla go kip tingbaut dat pauwa oba yu o da orda blo yu. Em mait bi bitwin 6 o 12 mants bipo yu go gede nada miting wea da Treatment Authority. Dem miting po dem Forensic Orda, ip yu bin meke samting prapa rong, ane Tritment Sapot Orda go apen ebri 6 mants.
16.	You can ask for an earlier hearing by completing and sending us an Applicant Review form, which can be found on our website.	Yu ken ask po mo erli miting ip yu filmaut ane sane mipla da Applicant Review form. Em wea da website blo mipla.
